### SUPPLY LIST

(estimated per 20 campers)

During the course of the summer the following list of supplies will be used in running an effective camping program for the children. The Camp Director will work with the Youth Center in rationing the supplies to last the course of the summer. Having the supplies ready and packaged for camp before the staff gets to the site would benefit both parties in obtaining a smooth running program. The following list is directed towards camps of twenty campers, exact quantity will vary with the size of the camp. Please note that the following is a suggested supply list. We realize that items are subject to local availability!

Apron, goggles, mask, rubber gloves, plastic spatula,  
pick-up powder, scoop bag, large disposal bags, floor wipes,  
& hand wipes

**COOK OUT SUPPLIES**

Weekly BBQ's are a high point of the week for the children and staff. The supplies needed for this event will vary depending on the number of the children involved in the program each week. The following is the suggested weekly BBQ supplies list based on a camp size of 20 children.
